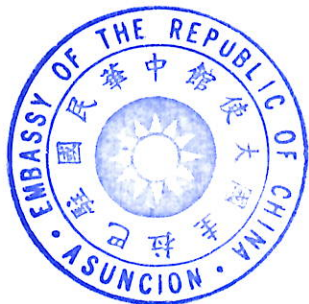
Honorable Ing. Lira R. Giménez:

**LETTER OF INTENT ON COOPERATION TO
PROMOTE TECHNICAL COOPERATION
BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA (TAIWAN) AND THE REPUBLIC OF PARAGUAY**

In recognition of the friendly diplomatic ties and with the mutual desire to develop closer relations, the Republic of China (Taiwan) and the Republic of Paraguay (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties") within the framework of the Agreement on Economic Cooperation between the Parties agree to collaborate on initiatives that would facilitate bilateral trade through enhanced regulatory cooperation.

The Parties declare their intention and affirm their commitment to explore cooperation on the following issues in the fields of standardization, metrology and conformity:

1. Conducting personnel exchanges to study, share experiences, engage in consultations, and train specialists on mutually agreed upon technical cooperation programs.
2. Providing information on significant changes to regulatory requirements under the jurisdictions of the Parties that could impact bilateral trade in goods.
3. Promoting and developing direct cooperation between conformity assessment bodies and scientific research institutes regarding standardization, laboratories, metrology, calibration, and conformity assessment procedures.
4. Organizing activities and promoting common projects concerning the development of quality infrastructure to enhance the capabilities and competitiveness of conformity assessment bodies.

The Parties agree that an agreement will be further concluded by the end of the year 2020 so as to map out substantive programs for the activities identified and other topics of mutual interest.

In witness hereof, the undersigned representatives of both Parties, duly authorized by their respective governments, hereby declare their assurance to uphold the understanding herein by signing this Letter of Intent.

This Letter of Intent is signed in the city of Taipei and Asunción respectively, on 24 September 2020, and shall enter into force on this date.
